# EGF Education Fall 2025 Grant Awards

With great pleasure, The East Grand Forks Education Foundation awarded 13 individuals, collaborative teams, and their fellow staff in the East Grand Forks Public School District grants totaling \$26,852.98 for a variety of projects that will impact students across grade levels. Grants were awarded to those applicants whose project applications met the grant requirements set forth by the Foundation. The Foundation has been awarding grants covering all disciplines for both classroom-level, grade level, and building-wide projects since 2010.

## Foundation Grant Award Recipients:

- Tracey Heisler, Brooke Shelstad, and Kristin Stenberg, 9th grade English staff, submitted a grant entitled **“English 9 Curriculum Alignment”** to purchase 180 copies of the novel **“Death Watch”** by Robb White which will be used to streamline freshman English curriculum. They were awarded full support in the amount of \$1,620.00.
- Katie Kleven, School Counselor and Yearbook Advisor/Desktop Publishing Teacher, submitted a grant entitled **“Yearbook Photography Supplies”** to purchase a camera package which would allow students to be more involved in documenting student life and photo editing experiences. She was awarded full support in the amount of \$1,096.92.
- Donovan Hanson and Emily Ruemmele, 9-12 Vocal Music Instructor and ILC instructor, submitted a grant entitled **“Senior High Adaptive Music.”** Funding from this grant will create a new Adaptive Music course at Senior High to allow special education students to receive music instruction. They were awarded full support in the amount of \$3,008.09.
- Jessica Genett, Visual Arts Educator, submitted a grant entitled **“Mural Design.”** Jessica’s initiative aims to create a class designed to prepare students for employment in both the designing and painting of large-scale public art murals. Jessica was awarded full support in the amount of \$1,509.00.
- Stacey Bach and Jenny Loer, Band Directors for grades 5-12, submitted a grant entitled **“5-12 Band Instrument Upgrade and Expansion.”** Their goal is to have instruments to accommodate as many players as possible. They were awarded partial funding in the amount of \$5,700.00.
- Hannah Driscoll, CMS Family Consumer Science Teacher, submitted a grant entitled **“Foods Around the World.”** With this funding she will be building a collection of cooking equipment to support cooking labs focused on different cultures and traditions. She was awarded full funding in the amount of \$850.00.
- Amanda Adams, 7th grade language arts teacher at the Central Middle School submitted a grant entitled **“Scope for Success: Empowering Young Readers One Story at a Time.”** Her project will be utilized to implement the use of a supplemental teaching tool to strengthen reading and writing skills through high interest, authentic stories and articles all while providing differentiation for diverse learners. Amanda was awarded full support in the amount of \$263.67.
- Leisa Hanson, 8th grade social studies teacher, at the Central Middle School, submitted a grant for entitled **“Enhancing Geography Learning through IXL Social Studies.”** Her hope with these materials is to interactive online lessons, practice questions, and real-time feedback aligned to MN Social Studies standards. She was awarded full support in the amount of \$831.25.
- Melissa Kroetsch and Carl Adolphson, South Point Administrators, submitted a grant proposal for **enhancing school culture with hallway and window graphics** and school spirit banners. They were awarded full funding in the amount of \$2,540.00.
- Danny Moffitt, South Point music teacher, submitted a grant proposal entitled **“South Point Stage Lighting.”** He intends to create a new atmosphere with new stage lighting to make performances come alive. He was awarded partial support in the amount of \$5,276.69.

- Elizabeth Hulst, New Heights Phy. Ed. teacher, submitted a grant proposal entitled **“Enhancing Physical Education and Cross Curricular Learning through Active Play Equipment.”** She was awarded full funding in the amount of \$847.80.

- Tina Haaven, Assistant Principal at New Heights Elementary, submitted a request for **signage to showcase school pride in every corner of the school.** Tina was awarded full funding in the amount of \$3,150.

- Amy McDonald, Kindergarten teacher at New Heights, submitted a grant request for funds to **refresh the Discovery Areas to enhance kindergarten learning before the bell.** She was awarded full funding in the amount of \$3,448.50.

The Foundation is excited to learn about all of the project outcomes and are truly in awe of the effort staff put forth each and every day to make East Grand Forks Public School District a great place for students to learn.
